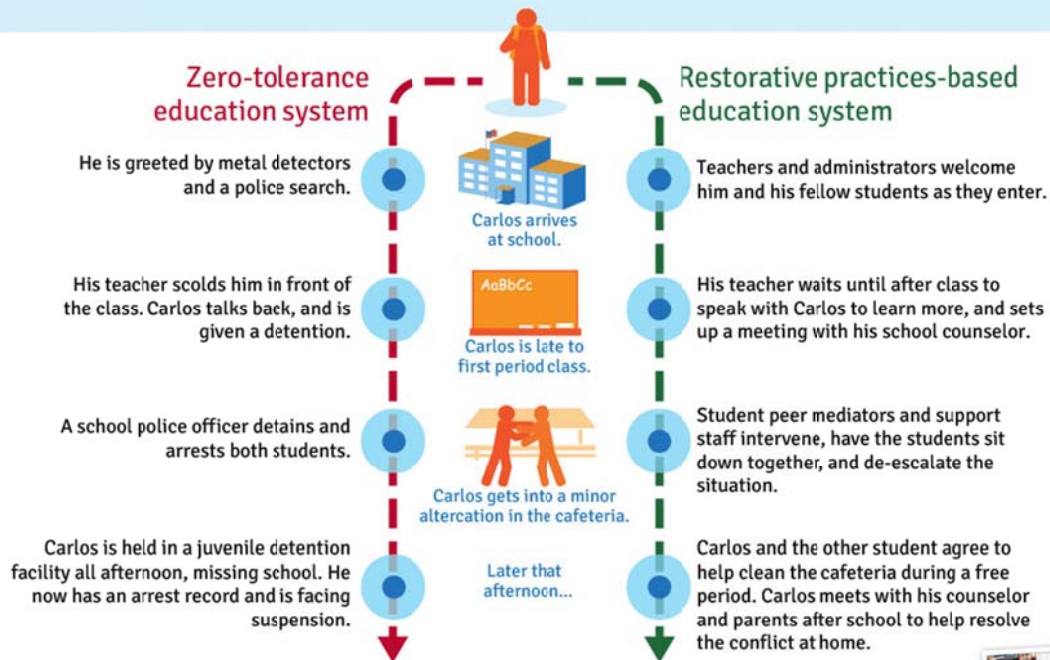

This is a very exciting time for St. Stephen Catholic School (SSCS) to be included in the valley-wide Restorative Justice (RJ)/Restorative Practice (RP) group. Through a generous grant from the Aspen Foundation, school and juvenile law enforcement leaders from the Roaring Fork Valley were invited to attend an RJ Conference in Vail; these leaders are now required to participate in an ongoing, valley-wide focus group to implement and support restorative practices in our schools and juvenile law enforcement. We are blessed in that through our ongoing relationship with Youth Zone, SSCS has been gradually implementing these restorative discipline practices into our school. These RP philosophies and practices tie in so beautifully with our Catholic teachings and beliefs. Teaching our children to resolve conflicts, accept responsibility for their actions and to realize how their actions impact others are lifelong skills.

A few years ago, our entire staff was trained in restorative practices. Now that other schools are catching onto Restorative Practices being part of best educational practices we at SSCS hope to benefit in networking with local schools and gaining mutual support in additional training and resources.

Currently, Ms. Cormier and Mrs. Hillbrand are working with a small group of parents and teachers to seek solutions and perhaps purchase a program to help to support us in promoting a positive climate throughout our school. They're working on finding ways to celebrate living out the cardinal and ordinal virtues that we have included in our logo and mission statement. I look forward to seeing what they create or find.
