La Escuela San Esteban pide su ayuda

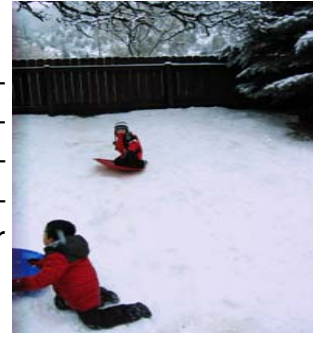

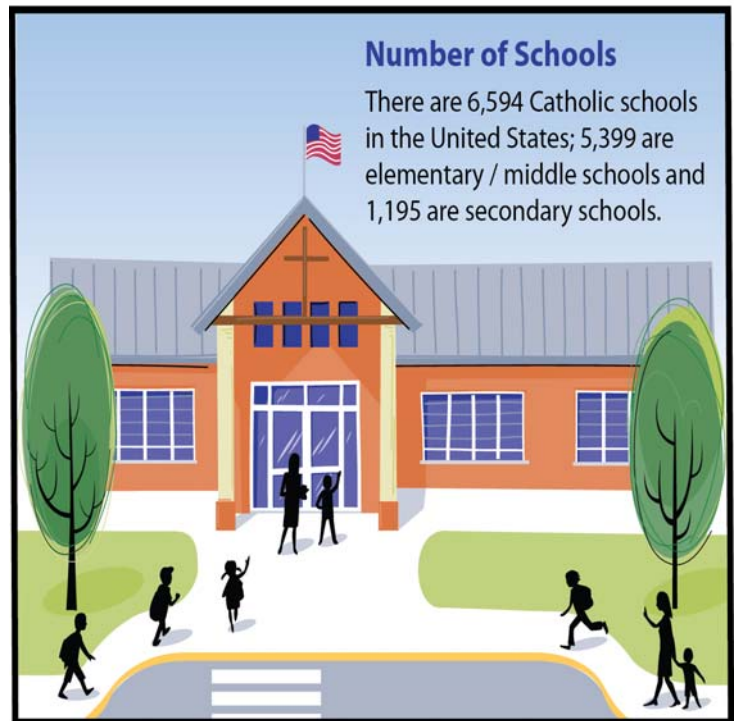

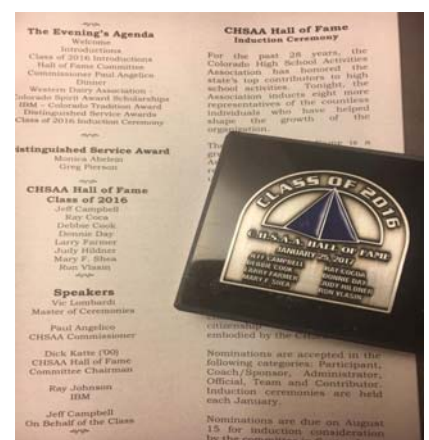
