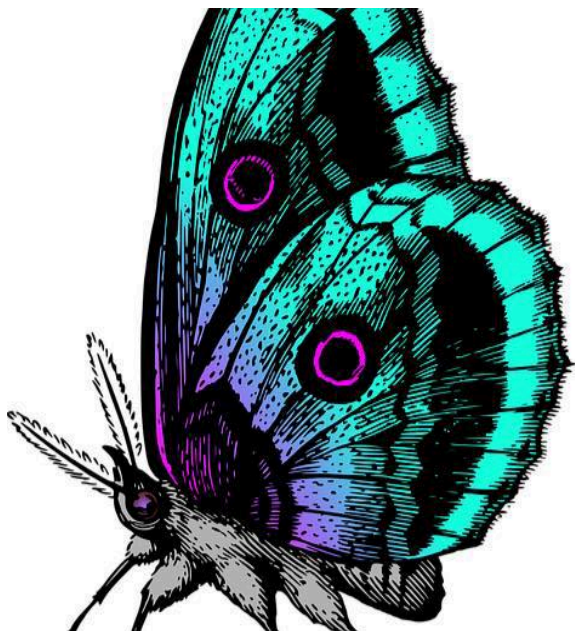

- St. Stephen Catholic School students and families raised \$1,380.06 for St. Catherine of Siena Catholic School in Port Arthur, TX in answer to a call for help when their school was flooded by Hurricane Harvey.
- St. Catherine of Sienna Catholic School, one of our LEI sister schools, in Port Arthur, Texas was flooded by Hurricane Harvey. Needless to say, they have been busy cleaning up these past few weeks. In addition to the loss of numerous teaching supplies, textbooks, and technology, this school had to pay \$60,000.00 in insurance deductibles.
- Thus, St. Catherine's can use all the help that they can get. Many of the families impacted by Harvey are still displaced from their homes and some have lost everything. They have all worked together get their beloved school cleaned up and they opened their doors to students on September 12th. However, they still have a long way to go to replace and rebuild what they have lost.
